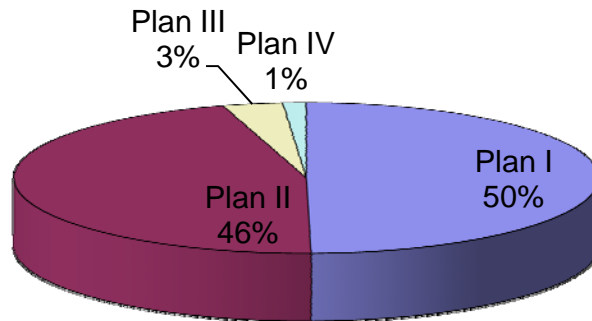

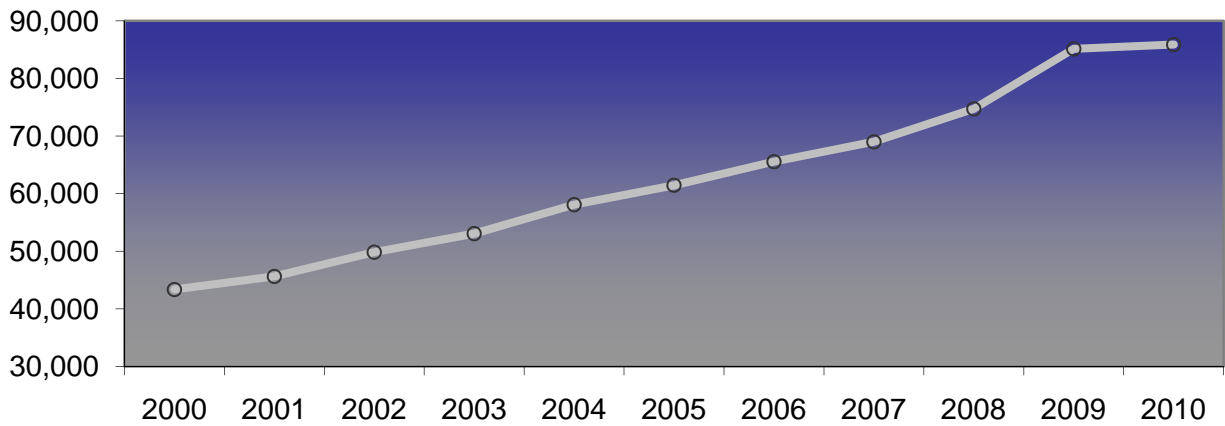

Membership 2000 to 2010



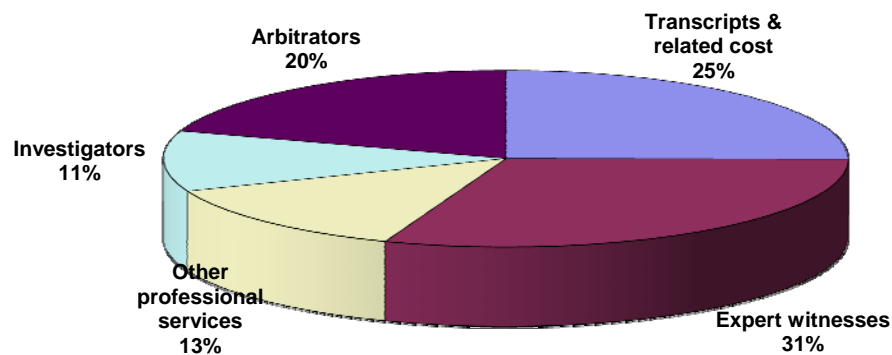

BENEFITS

The Legal Defense Fund only contracts with experienced lawyers and field representatives. As of December 31, 2009 the Fund has spent \$10,593,977 in legal fees.

In addition, the Fund pays for all customary, necessary and reasonable services associated with a case. As of December 31, 2009, the Fund has spent a total of \$ 1,268,351.00 for these services.
