As of September 30, 2009 the Legal Defense Fund had net assets of \$7,275,733.

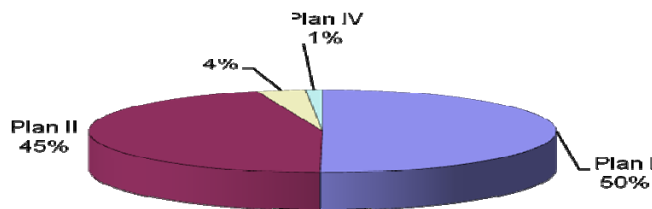

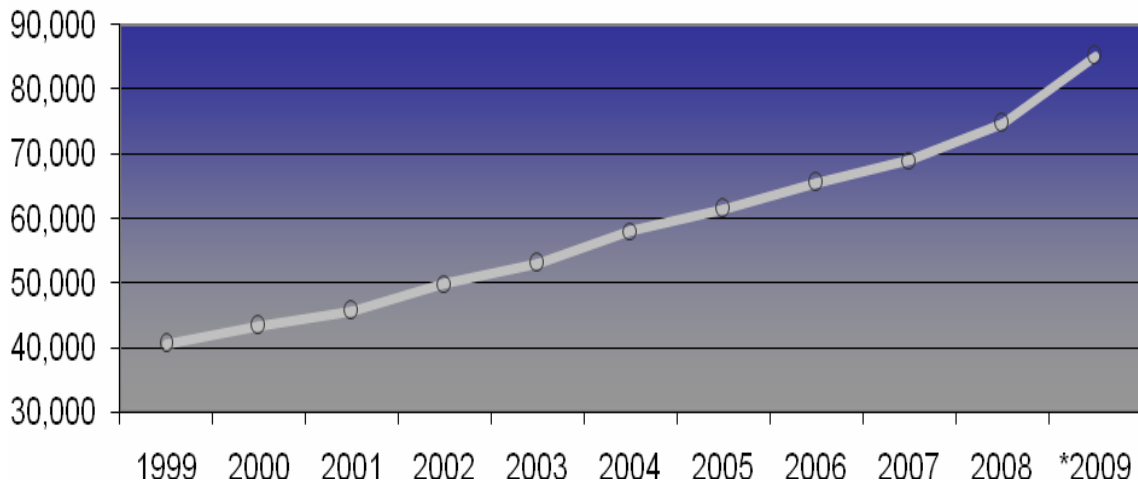

Membership 1999 to 2009



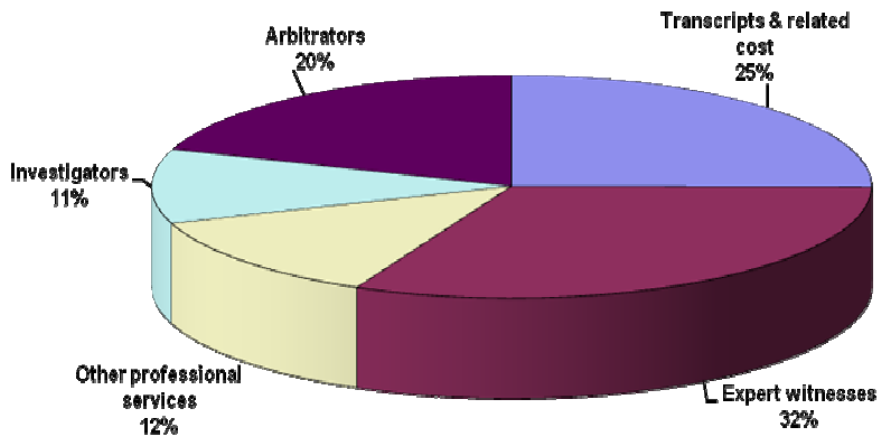

BENEFITS

The Legal Defense Fund only contracts with experienced lawyers and field representatives. As of September 30, 2009 the Fund has spent \$8,000,059 in legal fees.

In addition, the Fund pays for all customary, necessary and reasonable services associated with a case. As of September 30, 2009, the Fund has spent a total of \$972,899 for these services.
