

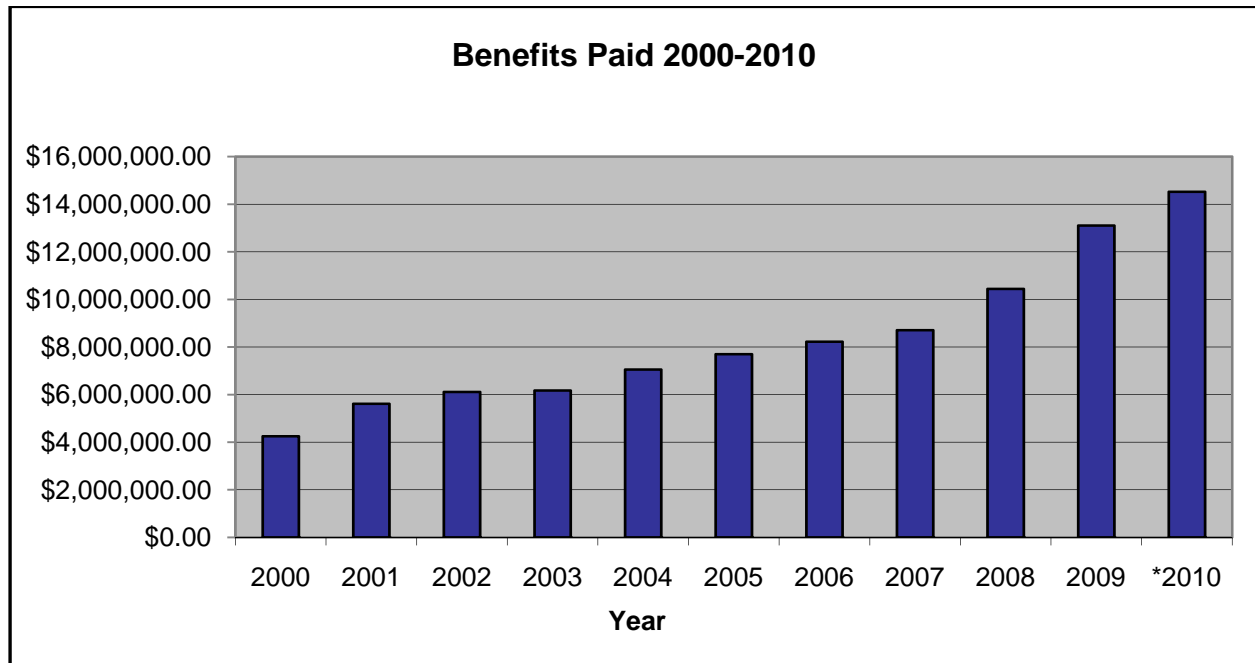

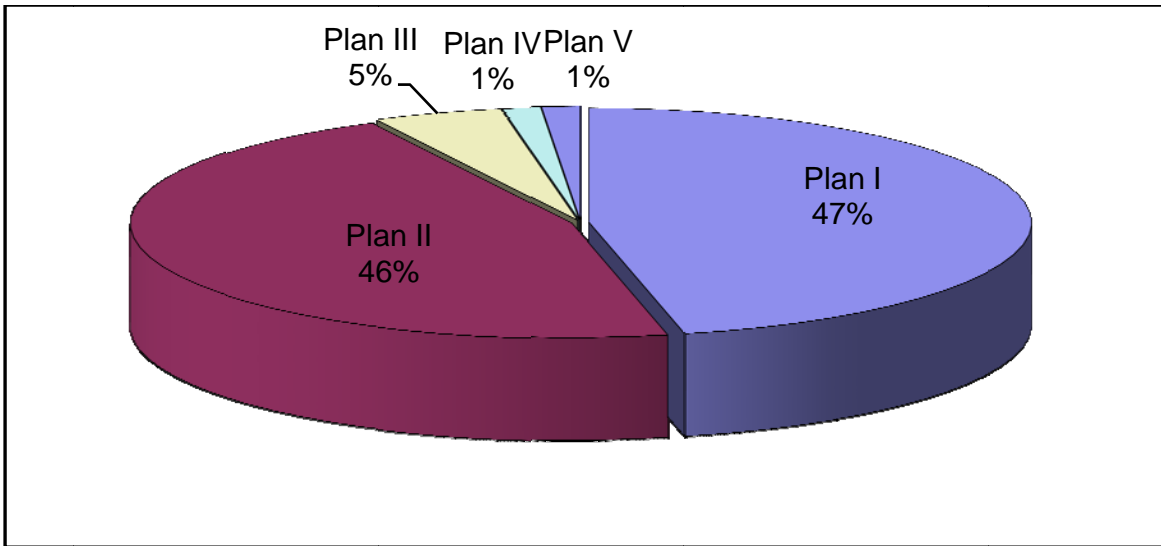
## ***MEMBERSHIP***

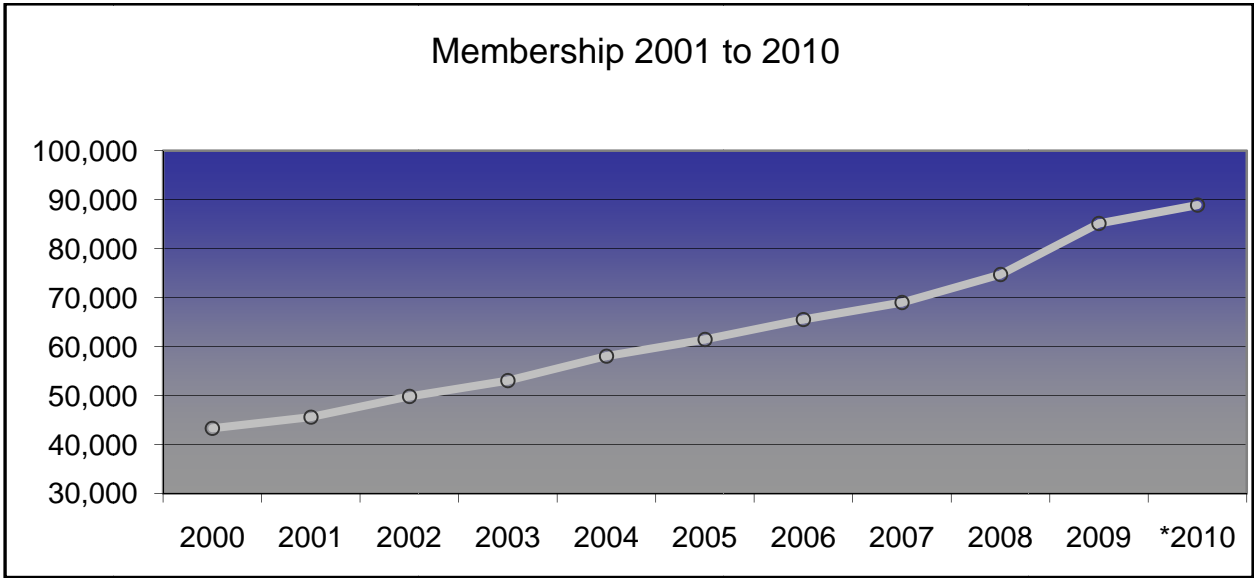
